## Blood Donation Camp-

Most of the tribal women are anemic and are often in life threatening situation especially during pregnancy. blood transfusion becomes life saver for the mother and the unborn child. ## Menstrual Hygiene Awareness Programme' at Maraknar:

Lok Biradari Prakalp celebrated its year ending on 30th December at beautiful tribal village named Maraknar in a 'Menstrual Hygiene Awareness Programme' for adolescent girls. It was organized with the help of Ms. Bhagyashri Lekhami a young Sarpanch (Elected Village Head) of Kothi Gram Panchayat. Around 150 girls & 50 women from surrounding 4 villages were gathered to attend the meeting. Dr. Anagha explained how to maintain hygiene during menstruation, how to dispose used sanitary pads without littering the environment. The girls were this menstruation awareness meeting was sponsored by Rotary Club of Bolton Lever, UK who has also assured the supply of sanitary pads for 1 year for 150 girls.



## Eye Surgery Camp

Surgical camps Could not be conducted due to pandemic. However, by considering growing number of patients, Lok Biradari Prakalp Hospital conducted an eye surgery camp on 21-12-2021 with the help of Dr. Adwait Appalwar. A total of 18 patients were operated during this camp.
